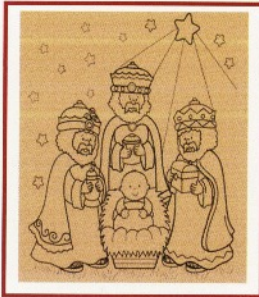

1: The Leat : Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January – Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2020.

Our annual task of clearing debris and overgrowth from the Leat will proceed throughout this week. The Cormac Tool Trolley will be parked near Brookside and work should start most days around 0930hrs.

The aim will be to maintain the watercourse from the West End Terrace down to the Carnon river.

2. The Millennium Green Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> January (start 1000hrs)

Also: Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January – Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January

*Lots of work to maintain the Green for wildlife, bio-diversity and recreation.*

a). Manage Hedges: - remove brambles and cut back sycamore growth before birds start nesting again.

b). Work on the Pond: ☉ Clear out invasive parrots feather weed growth and re-locate introduced lily plants to restore balance of open water. ☉ Restore perimeter access/walkway round the edge. ☉ Prepare ground for possible viewing platform and hide/screen.

c). Cut Rough Grass areas and prepare for wildflower sowing

d). Prune specific trees where necessary to remove dead wood and correct unbalanced growth.

## VILLAGE IN BLOOM 2021 (ViB)

Happy New Year to you all!

We had a very productive get-together back in November, planning for the ViB competition in 2021. An important aim is to ensure that new plantings will last and continue to look good for many years in the future.

This means we will concentrate on using perennial plants, including native wildflowers and aim to develop public spaces in the village that can be established this year (2020) and don't demand too much maintenance.

Pavement space is very limited so it will be important to look at walls and soft verges. We should use re-cycled materials for planters – if you have any ideas, please share them. Have you got room for a window box?

We want to involve as many Chacewater residents as possible. So, if you can donate some space for plants, if you have cuttings, or if you like weeding, get in touch! It all counts in the coming months.

Soon we will be drawing up a detailed "action plan", starting to prepare sites for planting and deciding plant selections. We hope to get advice from people experienced in working with the Royal Horticultural Society "in Bloom".

We get together again on **Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> January, 12.00 noon** at the Kings Head. Come along and have a chat, explore new ideas, it's informal and very friendly, we'd love to see you.

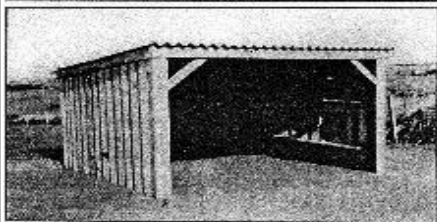

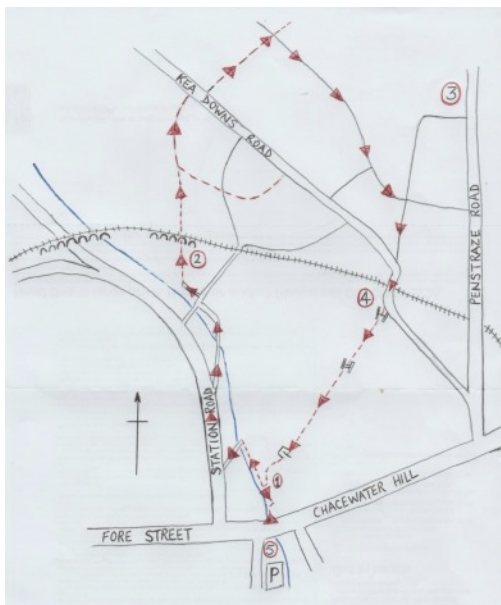

## CHACEWATER RIGHTS OF WAY (CRoW) WALK

Blue skies and sunshine met Sunday morning 1<sup>st</sup> December, encouraging 17 CRoW walkers to gather in good spirits. We agreed to follow a route walked last spring and set off from the village Car Park shortly after 9.30am, crossing the footbridge over the Carnon river. On the footpath we turned Left and noted the work done to reveal the stonework by the Grade II listed "Shute" village water cistern.

Across the main road at **Fore Street** we went along **Riverside** ① and followed the footpath beside the rushing waters of the Carnon river. At the end of the footpath, we turn left and briefly double back to turn right onto **Station Road**. Continue northwards for 200 m., past a row of large beech trees lining the road until it bears left uphill, where we take the right fork down to a broad trackway



The byway (20/4) crosses the stream and follows its wooded bank. Across another byway (20/2) we proceed for 80 m. on a driveway to a 5-barred gate. Here, we turn right uphill onto footpath (7/1) towards **Chacewater Viaduct** ② which carries the railway over the coombe by **Jolly's Bottom**. As we pass under the massive stone arches, we pause to watch the Penzance-London train overhead. The path skirts a small pasture and joins a well-made bridleway (7/4) running uphill, past old oak trees, to emerge on **Kea Downs Road**.

Turning right, we walk a short distance on the road and turn left onto a broad grassy bridleway (29/2). Puddles of overnight rain lie in the farm tracks that run dead straight across the plateau. At the end, we

turn right onto a wide byway (28/2), taking us past **Penstraze Farm**, until we follow the left fork onto byway (21/1). Arriving at crossways, we note the wide byway (30/1) ahead leads straight on to **Penstraze Road**, while the neat gravelled drive on the left, with unmarked footpath (21/3), runs towards the **Elm Tree Tearooms** ③.

We choose the right hand lane and turn south on the narrowest byway (30/2) which returns us to **Kea Downs Road** and the weak bridge over the railway. Across the bridge, work is progressing to renovate **Tamblyn's Barn**. We use the carefully protected stile ④ to join the footpath (17/2) across the field, pausing for a photograph as the sun shines across the valley.



The next stile is taken carefully as the bottom stone is slippery when wet. The well-trodden footpath (17/1) cuts diagonally across the first field and then beside the southern hedge all the way down to the valley floor. Despite recent heavy rainfall the

path is quite firm underfoot. All make it safely through the kissing gate and onwards to the footbridge over the river. Turning left we retrace our steps for 100 m. on **Riverside** and return to the village before 11.00am.

This was an enjoyable walk, easily managed by all. The newly-refurbished **Kings Head Hotel** ⑤ opened early and bar manager Adam provided refreshments for a dozen of us.

The next CRoW walk will be on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2020, leaving from the Car Park at 9.30 am. Everyone is very welcome to join in and greet the New Year.

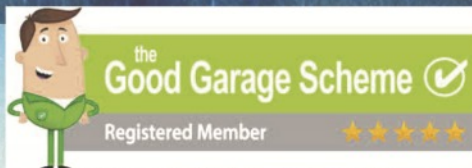
